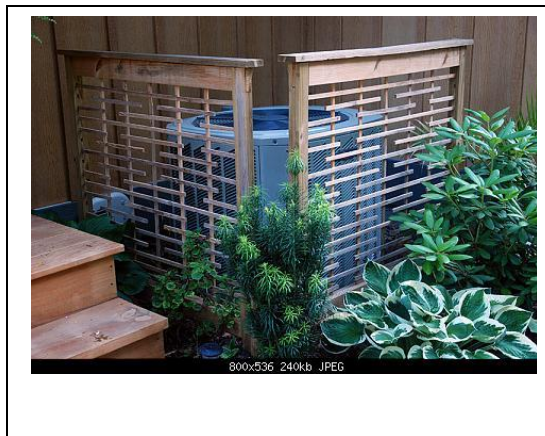

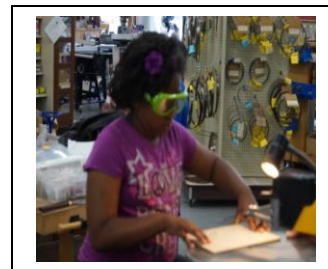

Barbara Ellison Forman, 63, passed away Saturday, June 6, 2015 at Beacon Place in Greensboro.
