Promotion Policy

April 20, 2009

This policy describes the classification levels of users on North Carolina Woodworker (www.ncwoodworker.net) and the qualifications required for promotion to the next level.

- Visitor any person that visits the website as a guest for reading purposes; Visitors may not post messages, pictures or download files. Registration is required to move to the next level.
- New User any person that has completed the website registration process and has been approved by the Webmaster. A New User must confirm an email to complete registration. A New User is promoted to User after sixty (60) days.
- <u>User</u> any User that has more than sixty (60) days of activity on the website. Promotion to Senior User requires all of the qualifications listed for that level.
- 4. <u>Senior User</u> any User that has more than 183 days of activity on the website, a minimum of 10 posts, a visitation frequency of at least 3 times per week and has posted an introduction about themselves to the website user community in the "Who We Are" Forum.
- 5. <u>Corporate Member</u> A Senior User may become a Corporate Member (a voting member of North Carolina Woodworker, Inc.) by maintaining all qualifications of a Senior User and by providing their full legal name, street address, regularly monitored email address and phone number on the NCWW Info page. In addition, they must explicitly "Opt-in" to become a Corporate Member and have paid any dues required by the Board of Directors.
