

#### **NEW CHAT TRIAL RUN**

Several people have suggested moving from a text-based chat to a video-based chat. I set up a video chat for Monday July 27 at 8:00 pm to 9:00 pm. This test used video conferencing software called Zoom.us. I have tested this on a PC running Windows 8, an Ipad, and an IPhone. I have not experienced any problems. It does require a free download.

I would like to test as many different systems as possible. Your participation need only take a few minutes just to see if we have technical problems. When joining, video is turned off. You can choose to share your video or not.

These videos can be recorded, eliminating the need for transcripts. This video conferencing software will also allow the sharing of desktops. This will be great for showing new members some of the features of the forum.

The test seemed to go well. I would like to hear if there were technical problems from any of the participants.
