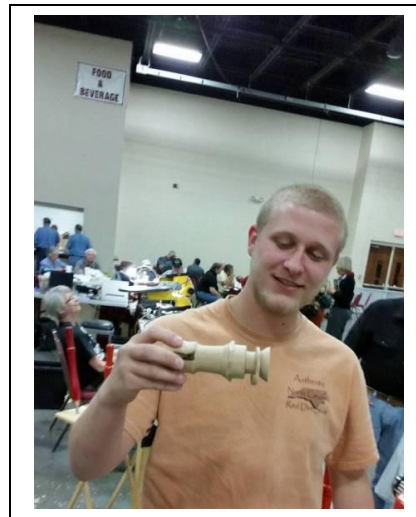

## **THE GUEST SPEAKER FOR NOVEMBER IS**

### **PAUL ANTHONY**

Paul is a woodworking photojournalist, and he is currently employed as senior editor at Woodcraft Magazine, where he conceives, writes, edits, and photographs articles aimed at beginning and intermediate woodworkers. In addition, he has started producing instructional videos as both short supplementary article material for the Web, and as full-length stand-alone features.

Over the past 20 years, Paul has authored and photographed several books for Taunton Press, including “The Complete Illustrated Guide to Tablesaws” and “Smart Workshop Solutions.” He has also written scores of magazine articles for the likes of American Woodworker, Popular Woodworking, Fine Woodworking, Wood, Woodworker’s Journal, and Woodcraft Magazine, and has edited a dozen or so books for Taunton press. As for video work, he has spent time on both sides of the lens, serving as talent for Craftsby.com, The Handyman Club of America and Microjig Industries, and as producer of a full-length video for the Taunton Press and a number of shorts for Woodcraft Magazine.

Over a thousand of his photos have seen print on the pages of books and magazines, including covers. He also shoots promotional and product photography for clients such as Marketshare Publications, 3 Links Productions, Adjust-a-Bench, Mitchell Guitars, and others.

He knows his subject, and can convey information clearly and concisely in both text and visuals. He also enjoys hitting the road at times to demonstrate the craft at national woodworking shows, and has taught classes for local (Allentown, PA) woodworking stores and adult education programs.

We have had other journalists on the chat before, but Paul will be the first photojournalist. I have talked with Paul and he is a very good speaker. I hope you will join us.
